1. WELCOME:

The chairman welcomed those present at the meeting including the new members.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The minutes of the members of Park to Park held on the 26th June 2013, had been circulated to all members prior to the meeting.

3. COMMITTEE REPORT:

Chairman's report had been circulated to all members prior to the meeting.

3.1 Security- Security is an ongoing issue that remains high priority for Park to Park. Although this area still has the lowest crime figures, members were warned not to be complacent and to regularly evaluate their individual security measures and to ensure that they are effective. The focus of the Park to Park is to manage and secure open public spaces in the precinct. Members were also encouraged to ensure that their properties are secure and well lit with white lights. Members were advised that they should ensure that the electric fences around their properties are well maintained and monitored.

3.2 Cleaning- Patricia and Simon were commended for an outstanding job of keeping the beaches clean. Noted that the staff is also equipped with radios to assist them to perform their role as security during the day.

3.3 Greening- Noted that there is much progress with the dune rehabilitation.

4. CAMERAS:

Dewet Geldenhuys briefed members.

Park to Park continues to evolve in terms of technology from Enforce. There are 32 cameras installed in the area. The cameras continue to contribute to the overall security system and although each camera is not monitored individually all the time, the system is monitored on a virtual patrol basis. Camera footage is available to the SAPS when requested. Dewet urged members to report anyone suspicious to Blue Security, Marshall Security or Enforce.

5. SECURITY REVIEW:

Jan Vogel briefed members.

- The festive season was a successful period with the UIP being very proactive.
- There was control of alcohol taken to the beach. There were no incidents reported.
- Jan Vogel, DeWet Geldenhuys and Brad Ross are part of the CPF.
- Jan advised members that systems are being put in place such as training for domestics. He encouraged members to be pro-active.

Jan urged residents to make use of the Enforce Helpline. All incidents MUST be reported using that line. Enforce Helpline - 086 111 2050. Trevor Edwards thanked the UIP for keeping the parks clean and assisting outside the Park to Park areas.

6. FINANCIAL REPORT:

Chairman advised that the financials are reasonably good. He thanked members for their contribution to the Park to Park. Noted that monthly contributions will increase in the future as the security services will increased by 8%.

7. **GENERAL:**

Mr Edwards advised that there was minimal crime in lower uMhlanga and there has been no incident on beach for 5 years. There is a sense of safety for all members
